Additional Notes re: Graduation Requirements

- Just a reminder, you MUST have 30 credits to graduate!!!!
- You must have a record of your completed 40 hours of community service in to Student Services by the end of April. If this is not done , your graduation application can not be processed.
- Students who learn in June that they will not be graduating because they have either not completed their volunteer hours or they have failed a credit (leaving them short of the required 30 credits) will be refunded half of their graduation fee they have already submitted.
- Students who have completed courses outside of CtK must ensure that all marks are showing on their CtK transcript.

Scholarships and Bursaries- Several community awards (Lion's Club and the Cdn. Federation of University Women-Georgetown) are being offered to students attending college and university. You lose nothing by applying! Applications are available in student services.

Grad Ceremony Packages: This will be distributed in early June in Student Services. It will include an invitation, a letter regarding procedures and 4 guest passes
